We are exceptionally pleased with this year's draft of sale rams despite the extremely challenging season in the Karoonda area. The strength of the genetics we have embedded in the Kamora Park flock really is shining through, with these rams visually displaying their excellent body length and carcase traits.

We have been undertaking measured performance for over a decade, including body and fleece weights, plus eye muscle and fat scanning of all rams at 10 months of age. This takes all subjectivity out of selections and ensures we are identifying the best performers for both wool and body weights.

The usual lustrous, free growing and well defined Kamora Park wools are also showing through on our sale team. The economic advantages of the rapid growth rates that have resulted are evident in the current buoyant sheep and lamb meat markets. For example, after our February classing we sent the bottom 114 ram lambs to slaughter at TFI Murray Bridge, aged 10 months. They had an average carcase weight of 35.8kg and returned \$175.40 per head including skins. This was on top of the 6 months of wool they had cut previously.

We strongly encourage your inspection and look forward to catching up and having a chat at any of the 2016 field days and shows.
